The Bible In The News... **Remembering D-DAY, 1944**

Every year the French have a 4-day celebration in Normandy complete with American uniforms, tanks, jeeps and guns. They still honor the Americans who died there - June 6, 1944 - the 74th anni-



versary of "D-Day". This was the largest invasion ever attempted, where 200,000 Americans stormed the beaches at Normandy to begin the final push to defeat Nazi Germany in WWII. D-Day marked the turning point in WWII in Europe. Today, European heads of state make it a point to recall and honor the sacrifices of those who landed in Normandy, as do our Presidents... since 1984. In the 74 years since D-Day, there are four occasions when the President of the United States chose not to visit the D-Day Monument that



honors the soldiers killed during the Invasion. The occasions were: 1) Barack Obama - 2010, 2) Barack **Obama - 2011, 3) Barack Obama - 2012, 4) Barack Obama - 2013.** Although Barack Obama was at the ceremony in Normandy in 2009, he did not attend the next four years. Six thousand plus Americans were killed that day on the beaches of Normandy...

"Be Strong In the LORD.... And In the Power Of His Might!"



Pentecost occurred on May 20th this year; what is Pentecost? The word "Pentecost" - which means 50 - is the 50th day after Passover. In Deuteronomy 16:9, the LORD commanded that after observing Passover with unleavened bread, that Israel would count seven weeks, or 49 days, and then begin the Feast of First Fruits - the Feast of

Weeks - later called Pentecost, or Shavuot. This was in commemoration of the spring harvest. The number "49" is very significant because it is the square of the holy or complete number SEVEN: 7 squared = 49. At this feast, two loaves of bread and a "kid of the goats," were offered for a sin offering. The two loaves of bread represent Israel and Gentiles, coming together as one.

JESUS - Yeshua - Who is called the Bread of Life and the Lamb of GOD, became the spiritual loaves and the sacrifice offering for sin (sin offering) of the New Covenant. It is truly significant that JESUS is called "The Firstfruit from the dead": "Now is Christ risen from the dead, the Firstfruits of them that sleep." (I Corinthians 15:20) In the Christians tradition, Pentecost has taken on a new meaning, as this was the moment that Holy Spirit came and filled a small group of Jewish men and women (120 of them) with "Power from on high!" (Acts 2:4)

Holy Spirit - the Spirit of Truth in John 16:13 - comes to dwell in each and every Believer and is: 1) Your Helper or Comforter (Greek = Paraclete), 2) Your Teacher Who instructs you in the things of GOD, 3) Your Intercessor - Spirit of Truth - Who leads you into all the truth, and 4) Your Guide, Who reveals to you the future - things to come...it is a wonderful time to celebrate the Glory of GOD...His Presence in YOU!
