Then David confessed to Nathan, "I have sinned against the LORD." Nathan replied, "Yes, but the LORD has forgiven you, and you won't die for this sin. Nevertheless, because you have shown utter contempt for the LORD by doing this, your child will die." After Nathan returned to his home, the LORD sent a deadly illness to the child of David and Uriah's wife...and on the seventh day the child died. David then wrote Psalms 32 and 51, repenting of his grave sins against GOD: Psalm 51:1-13 (NASB) "According to Thy Loving-kindness, Father, have mercy on my sinful, wretched soul. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. For I

know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against You, and You only, I have sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified when You speak and blameless when You judge. Behold, You desire truth in the innermost being, and in the hidden part You will make me know wisdom. Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me to hear joy and gladness again, let the bones which You have broken rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O GOD, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your Presence and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and sustain me with a willing spirit. Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners will be converted to You."

Just as GOD heard David's confession of wrong-doing and sin, <u>He will hear you when you confess your sins</u>, "...and He is faithful and just to forgive your sins and cleanse you from all unrighteousness!" (I John 1:9)

There may be times in your life that you will find yourself in a situation where you say something like, "Where did that come from? How did I get myself in this mess? LORD, what came out of my mouth is not what I had planned to say!!" If you haven't found yourself in that humbling moment when you've over-stepped your bounds or gotten involved in something that GOD never intended for you, you have a membership in "Christians Causing Confusion" (CCC), because this walk with the LORD isn't a life of perfect behavior, but a life of taking-up-your-cross obedience.

There was a man of GOD - a man after GOD's heart – who found himself "whopper-jawed" with GOD. He loved GOD...there is no question about that... but he found that he wanted something (someone) and ignored GOD's will in his life....He is King David in II Samuel 11-12:

As King of Israel, King David could, because of his authority and power, have anything he wanted. One night he saw a beautiful woman bathing, and he sent for her; he defiled her and committed <u>Adultery</u>. This was not in GOD's game plan for King David. Well, the woman became pregnant, and to cover his sin, King David devised an evil plan to do away with her husband, which eventually ended in Uriah's death...Murder!

In order to get David's attention, GOD went to his prophet, Nathan, and told him to go the David with a story of great conviction and truth...and here is what Nathan the prophet told King David: "There were two men in a certain town; one was rich, and one was poor. The rich man owned a great many sheep and cattle. The poor man owned nothing but one little lamb he had bought. He raised that little lamb, and it grew up with his children. It ate from the man's own plate and drank from his cup. He cuddled it in his arms like a baby daughter. One day a guest arrived at the home of the rich man. But instead of killing an animal from his own flock or herd, he took the poor man's lamb and killed it and prepared it for his guest."

David was furious. "As surely as the LORD lives," he vowed, "any man who would do such a thing deserves to die! He must repay four lambs to the poor man for the one he stole and for having no pity." Then Nathan said to David, "You are that man! The LORD, the GOD of Israel, says: 'I anointed you King of Israel and saved you from the power of Saul. I gave you your master's house and his wives and the kingdoms of Israel and Judah. And if that had not been enough, I would have given you much, much more. Why, then, have you despised the Word of the LORD and done this horrible deed? For you have murdered Uriah the Hittite with the sword of the Ammonites and stolen his wife. From this time on, vour family will live by the sword because you have despised Me by taking Uriah's wife to be your own. Because of what you have done, I will cause your own household to rebel against you. I will give your wives to another man before your very eyes, and he will go to bed with them in public view (Absalom disgraced his father, David). You did it secretly, but I will make this happen to you openly in the sight of all Israel."

Beware of the consequences of sins that may look desirable at the time. (King David's reaction and answer to Nathan's charge is on page 4)



The Tomb of the UNKNOWN SOLDIER - the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier is continually being honored with a 21-gun

salute. Every 21 seconds, the Sentinel guarding the tomb turns, pauses for 21 seconds and then takes 21 steps forward...and repeats it over and over. There has been a Sentinel repeating this pattern since July 2, 1937, but the tomb dates back to 1921, when Congress approved a resolution for an unidentified soldier from World War I to be buried at Arlington. The Sentinels are volunteers, who are members of the 3rd U.S. Infantry Regiment. They must be between 5' 10" and 6' 4", and they are able to recite seven pages of Arlington Cemetery history word for word. They walk at a pace of 72 beats per minute and they spend hours practicing their steps with a metronome. They get haircuts twice a week, each taking care of his weapon and uniform. They honor the fallen unknown in all weather conditions. They remained at their posts through Hurricane Isabel, Hurricane Irene and Hurricane Sandy...loyal to the end.


