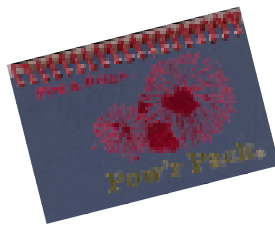

Which America?

Rosemary LaBonte wrote this article to a California newspaper in response to an article written by Ernie Lujan who suggests we should tear down the Statue of Liberty because the immigrants of today aren't being treated the same as those who passed through Ellis Island and other ports of entry. The paper never printed this response, so her husband sent it out via internet.

"Maybe we should turn to our history books and point out to people like Mr. Lujan why today's American is not willing to accept this new kind of immigrant any longer.

Back in the 1900's when there was a rush from all areas of Europe to come to the United States, people had to get off a ship and stand in a long line in New York to be documented. Some would even get down on their hands and knees and kiss the ground. They made a pledge to uphold the laws and support their new country in good and bad times. They made learning English a primary rule in their new American households and some even changed their names to blend in with their new home. They had waved goodbye to their birth place to give their children a new life and did everything in their power to help their children assimilate into one culture. Nothing was handed to them...no free lunches, no welfare, no labor laws to protect them. All they had were the skills and craftsmanship they had brought with them to trade for a future of prosperity.

Most of their children came of age when World War II broke out. My father fought alongside men whose parents had come over from Germany, Italy, France and Japan. None of these 1st generation Americans ever gave any thought about what country their parents had come from. They were Americans fighting Hitler, Mussolini and the Emperor of Japan. They were defending the United States of America as one people.

When we liberated France, no one in those villages were looking for the French, the German or the Irish Americans; they saw only Americans. And they carried one flag that represented one country. Not one of those immigrant sons would have thought about picking up another country's flag and waving it to represent who they were. It would have been a disgrace to their parents who had sacrificed so much to be here. These immigrants truly knew what it meant to be an American. They stirred the melting pot into one red, white and blue bowl...America!

And here we are with a new kind of immigrant who wants the same rights and privileges, only they want to achieve it by playing by a different set of rules, one that includes the entitlement card and a guarantee of being faithful to their mother country. I'm sorry,

that's not what being an American is all about. I believe that the immigrants who landed on Ellis Island in the early 1900's deserve better than that for all the toil, hard work and sacrifice in raising future generations to create a land that has become a beacon for those legally searching for a better life. I think they would be appalled that they are being used as an example by those waving foreign country flags!"

THE CONSTITUTION AND THE BIBLE:

“When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; but when the wicked rule, the people mourn.” (Proverbs 29:2)

The United States' Constitution was signed September 17, "...in the year of our LORD," 1787. Today, we are often led to believe that it was a product of secularism, but that is not true. Before the founding fathers ever sat down to write a Constitution, they had behind them more than 150 years or so of constitution-making of sorts by various Christian settlers of this country. The Mayflower Compact of 1620 was the first such example. The Pilgrims put on paper a political charter based on the biblical concept of covenant. This was the first of about 100 or so charters, compacts, and frames of government, paving the way to the Constitution. In 1639, a Puritan colony produced the Fundamental Orders of Connecticut, which mentions the importance of **“the Gospel of our LORD JESUS.”** That document was inspired by a sermon and was a key step on the way to the U.S. Constitution. That is why Connecticut prides itself as being “the Constitution State.” A study of the fifty-five founders who met in Philadelphia in 1787 and produced what has been called “The Miracle In Philadelphia” found that at least 52 of them were men in good standing with Trinitarian churches. These were not secular men, but Christians. While John Adams was not present during the proceedings, he nonetheless played a pivotal role in the nation's founding. He said, “Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.” It is a time to thank GOD for the rich heritage we have, a heritage founded upon the Word of GOD! **“It was for Freedom that JESUS set you FREE!”** (Galatians 5:1)

Heart Cries...

When I hosted “DERIN'S COFFEE SHOP” I received scores of phone calls every week. Holy Spirit gave me a term that describes the cries of peoples' hearts - **“Heart Cries”**. I asked the T.V. audience to send me their **“Heart Cries”** and I was amazed as people came out of their personal prisons to share their pain and grief with me. As I lifted each powerful story up to JESUS, He performed painless surgery and set people free! When a person experiences these deep emotional and spiritual hurts, counseling and surface answers will not bring the release the wounded person needs. Healing does not occur at the emotional, psychological level; it's experienced in the person's heart, at the spirit level. The answer to their **“Heart Cry”** will come only when JESUS performs inner healing as only He can do. When He holds the broken heart in His hands and pours the soothing Anointing of His Love on those hurting wounds, then and only then, does the person have a chance for complete healing. JESUS has the answer for those **“Heart Cries”**, but you must allow Him access so He can heal the memories and take away the paralytic hurt. When JESUS is allowed access to your deep and hidden fears and pain, He will take away trauma and the persistent painful memories that follow a traumatic occurrence. His Word says, **“He heals the broken hearted and sets the prisoners free”** (Luke 4:18) because you cannot experience real freedom until your heart is healed! One particular **“Heart Cry”** stands out in my mind from a grandmother I met in Cheyenne. She told me of the day she had kept her grandson, and her daughter came to pick him up. He had begged to stay with her, but he went with his mother. That afternoon a horrific hail storm hit Cheyenne. On the way home her daughter and grandson were caught in the down-pour and drowned. I said to her, “It must be like walking with a stone in your shoe.” She looked me straight in the eyes and slapped her chest and said in pain, **“It's not in my shoe; it's in my heart!”** Of course I prayed for her right there at her work, and JESUS, in His great Love and Power set her free! I've seen her off and on the last few years and she's always smiling and at peace with what happened to her grandson and her daughter in that terrible storm. As you read this, you can decide today to allow JESUS (He comes by invitation) to enter your heart at the deepest level to bring healing, freedom and joy into your life...TODAY! When you do this, He will take your burdens and stress on His big shoulders and make you FREE indeed (John 8:36)! He is ready...right NOW...to touch and make you whole!
