
Maybe it's been awhile since you've checked your attitude; with this world getting crazier by the minute, it's important that you keep on top of things spiritually. So, what does Paul say about attitude in Ephesians 4:17? "Speaking for the LORD, let me say this: Live no longer as the unsaved do, for they are blinded and confused - they walk in their empty delusians, shuting their minds to GOD's ways. They don't care any more about right and wrong and have given themselves over to impure ways. They stop at nothing, being driven by their evil minds and reckless lusts.

But that isn't the way Christ taught you!"

Paul goes on to say that if you have really heard His voice and learned from Him how to live, then He gives you a command to work on getting rid of the old habits and attitudes you learned from the world - pride and selfish behavior - and allow Holy Spirit to work in your spirit to get new attitudes and thoughts from GOD Himself. You, allowing GOD to work in you, makes you a new person: 1) Clothe yourself with this new nature, 2) Stop lying to each other; tell the truth, for we are parts of each other and when we lie to each other we are hurting ourselves, 3) Don't let anger control you or be fuel for revenge...not even for a day. Don't go to bed angry; get over it! For when you are angry, you give a mighty foothold to the devil, 4) Stealing and coveting must stop! Begin using those hands for honest work so you can give to others in need, 5) And never let ugly or hateful words come from your mouth; let your words become beautiful gifts that encourage others, speaking words of grace to help them, 6) Never grieve the Spirit of GOD or take for granted His holy influence in your life; He has sealed you in Christ JESUS until you experience your full salvation and sanctification." (Ephesians 4:22-30)

JESUS desiring that you have a godly attitude, tells a story about a fair employer and greedy workers in Matthew 20:1-16: "The owner of an estate went out early one morning to hire workers for his harvest field. He agreed to pay them \$20 a day and sent them out to work. A couple of hours later he saw some idle men, and hired them also, after agreeing on what they would be paid. At noon and again around three o'clock in the afternoon he did the same thing. At five o'clock he was in town, and again found men standing around, who agreed to work for him. That evening, he called the men in to pay them, paying the last men first. When the men hired at five o'clock each received \$20, the men who were hired early in the day, assumed they would receive much more, but they too, were paid \$20. They protested, 'Those fellows worked only one hour, and yet you've paid them just as much as those of us who worked all day in the scorching heat.' 'Friend,' he answered one of them, 'I did you no wrong! Didn't you agree to work all day for \$20? It is my desire to pay all the same; is it against the law to give away my money if I want to? Should you be angry because I am kind?' And so it is that the last shall be first, and the first, last." What would be your reaction, seeing employees working only a couple hours getting paid the same as you who worked all day?


does, you're fired! He is a guy who asks lots of questions. The questions he asks aren't cloaked in fancy "political" phrases; they are "why the hell..." questions.
