There is so much fear in this world...people trying desperately to be distracted from what’s going on. They are endeavoring to keep a good attitude by spending time being entertained and keeping themselves busy with things that don’t come into play when tomorrow arrives - they are wrapped up in activities and projects that keep their minds off of what’s really happening. Make America Great Again!

This is a conundrum of amazing history facts about Presidents Lincoln and Kennedy:

Abraham Lincoln was elected to Congress in 1846; John F. Kennedy was elected to Congress in 1946.

Lincoln was elected President in 1860; Kennedy was elected President in 1960. Both were focused on civil

rights. Both presidents lost a child while living in the White House. Both presidents were shot on a Friday; both presidents were shot in the head.

Now it really becomes strange in regarding their legacies:

Lincoln's secretary was named Kennedy; Kennedy's secretary was named Lincoln. Both were assassinated by men from the south. Both were succeeded by southerners named Johnson; Andrew Johnson, who succeeded Lincoln, was born in 1808; Lyndon B. Johnson, who succeeded Kennedy, was born in 1908. John Wilkes Booth, who assassinated Lincoln, was born in 1839. Lee Harvey Oswald, who assassinated Kennedy, was born in 1939. Both assassins were known by their three names...both names are composed of 15 letters.

Now, hang onto your seat: Lincoln was shot in the theater named "Ford". Kennedy was shot in a car - a Lincoln - made by Ford. Both Booth and Oswald were assassinated before their trials.

Here's the kicker: A week before Lincoln was shot, he was in Monroe, Maryland; a week before Kennedy was shot, he was with Marilyn Monroe. But wait...there's more: Lincoln was shot in a theater and the assassin ran to a warehouse; Kennedy was shot from a warehouse and his assassin ran to a theater. What a coincidence...or was it?

"Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty... I will rejoice in the GOD of my salvation... The LORD GOD is my strength, and He has made my feet like hinds' feet and makes me walk on my high places!" (Habakkuk 3:17-18)



"The Eye Of the Needle...."

There has been much discussion about JESUS' comments regarding rich peoples' likelihood of not going to heaven...He likened it to a camel going through "the eye of a needle": **"It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter into GOD's Kingdom."** (Mark 10:25) Some theorize that the needle JESUS was speaking of was the Needle Gate, supposedly a low and narrow after-hours entrance found in the wall surrounding Jerusalem. It is said that it was purposely small for security reasons, and a camel could only go through it by stripping off any saddles or packs and crawling through on its knees.

The problem with this theory is there is no evidence such a gate ever existed in JESUS' time, and only appeared around 700 AD. The word translated "camel" (Greek: *kamelos*) should actually be "rope" (*kamilos*). See the similarities in the Greek? Then the verse would read, **"It is easier for a rope to go through the eye of a needle...."**

The most likely explanation is that JESUS was using a figure of speech that exaggerates for emphasis. JESUS used this technique at other times, referring to a "plank" in one's eye (Matthew 7:3-5) and swallowing a camel (Matthew 23:24). JESUS' message is clear - **it is impossible for anyone to be saved on his own merits.** The disciples were utterly amazed and asked, "Who then can be saved?" in the next verse. JESUS' answer is the basis of the gospel: **"With man this is impossible, but not with GOD; all things are possible with GOD."** (Matthew 19:26). Men are saved through GOD's gifts of grace, mercy, and faith (Ephesians 2:8-9). Nothing we do earns salvation for us. It is the poor in spirit who inherit the Kingdom of GOD (Matthew 5:3), those who recognize their spiritual poverty and their utter inability to do anything to justify themselves to a holy GOD. The rich man so often is blind to his spiritual poverty because he is proud of his accomplishments and has contented himself with his wealth. He is as likely to humble himself before GOD as a camel is to crawl through the eye of a needle.

Knowing the True Meaning of Psalm 23...

Years ago the great actor Richard Burton was given a grand reception in his childhood parish. While replying to the complimentary speeches in the parish auditorium he asked if there was anything they specially wanted to hear from him. After a minute's pause his old pastor asked him if he could recite the Good Shepherd Psalm (Psalm 23), which he had taught Burton in his Sunday school. A strange look came over the actor's face. He paused for a moment, and then said, "I will, on one condition - that after I have recited it, you, my pastor and teacher will do the same." "I am not an actor," said the old, retired pastor, "but, if you want me to recite it, I shall do so." The actor began quoting Psalm 23; his voice and intonation were perfect. He held his audience spellbound, and as he finished, a great burst of applause broke from the audience.



As it died away, the old pastor rose from his wheelchair and began to recite the same Psalm. His voice was feeble and shivering and his tone was not faultless. But, when he finished, there was not a dry eye in the room. The actor rose and his voice quivered as he said, "Ladies and gentlemen, I reached your eyes and ears, but my pastor has reached your hearts. The difference is just this: **I know the Psalm, but he knows the Shepherd.**" JESUS wants us to know Him by experiencing Him and to become good shepherds to those entrusted to our care.

David wrote the 23rd Psalm when he was in King Saul's palace, playing his lyre for the king. Several times an evil spirit came upon King Saul and he tried to pin David to the wall with a spear. But David slipped away out of Saul's presence and fled into the night. David was in a very dangerous place when he wrote Psalm 23:

"The LORD is my Shepherd, I shall not want for anything. He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters; He restores my soul. He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil...my cup runs over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever!"

Halloween - "the devil's holiday"

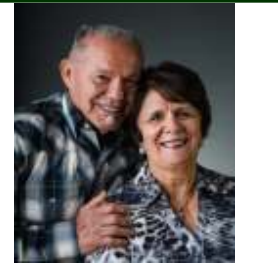
